

Prospicio, The Placement Cell of Kamala Nehru College has progressed over the years and eventually became a landmark of excellence. It is representative of ideation, innovation and tenacity. It has thus, in these parameters, successfully surpassed our initial expectations- so much, that each year, the Prospicio team unfailingly witnesses an escalating graph. The driving force behind our team is our esteemed teacher conveners, consisting of Ms. Nidhi Bhandari, Mr. Sahil Ramchandani and Mr. Joseph Kumar Ravi, Student Coordinators Navya Aggarwal (President) and Jayshree (Vice President) from the academic year 2021-22 who passed on the baton to Ishika Garg (President), Anoushka Choudhary (Vice President) for the academic year 2022-23 along with a dedicated team of 22 young women, of whom 12 have been serving as the placement coordinator and 10 students from the first year have recently been recruited to join the coveted cell.

The Placement Season for the Batch 2022 began in August 2021 and went on till July 2022 witnessing around 110+ recruiters across diverse domains, with 371 registrations and 114 students being placed at a rate of 30% demonstrating that Prospicio has found enormous prospects to drive growth and bridge the gap between students and recruiters. The highest CTC offered was 23 LPA by The D.E. Shaw Group to Ananya Singh (B.A Economic Hons) for the profile of Financial Research Associate with an average of 4.85 LPA.

The ongoing Placement Season for the Batch of 2023 began in August 2022 and till January 2023 more than 30 companies visited the campus, ensuring the placement of 90 driven students. The highest CTC offered in the present academic session till date has been 8.94 LPA by Accenture with an average of 5.1 LPA. Candidates from not only the Science and Commerce streams, but also from Humanities were offered profiles from various domains such as consulting, administrative assistance, graphic design and content writing apart from the positions of finance, business development, sales and marketing, etc. from leading companies like Ernst and Young (EY), KPMG, PWC, Accenture and Boston Consulting Group (BCG) to name a few.

The Internship Season began in February 2022 and is still ongoing seeing 130+ reputed companies and startups on campus offering diverse profiles for students across departments. Around 1200 students applied for the internship opportunities out of which 509 offer letters were successfully rolled out. It was an amalgamation of both paid and unpaid opportunities by companies like: - Michael Page, Oppo, Newzera, Bain and Co. etc.

The most anticipated annual offline career and internship fair "PHOENIX 4.0" by Placement Cell was held on 20th January 2023 in the college premises. The event witnessed the presence of Prof. Urvashi Sharma, chairperson of the governing council of Kamala Nehru College, Mr. Naveen Seth, Assistant Secretary General at PHD Chambers of Commerce and Mr. Anupam Garg, Senior Manager at Capgemini Engineering. With over 1300 registrations from all across University of Delhi and 400+ students gracing the campus, a total of 320 offers have already been rolled out and many are still awaited. Out of these selected candidates 207 students were from Kamala Nehru College and rest from across the University of Delhi. This year's Internship Fair solidified the deep relationship of the Institute with the corporate sector as 40+ prestigious companies were onboarded which reflects the value-based trust of the companies in everything we have to offer. Furthermore, Students gained industry exposure which enhanced the practical aspects of their learning process.

The Best Manager Competition held on 6th July 2022 was a unique Initiative by The Placement Cell to give the participants a deep understanding of industry requirements. The competition aimed to offer a chance for participants to gain substantial experience, showcase skills, analyze and evaluate outcomes and uncover personal aptitude.

The placement cell has offered a plethora of learning opportunities for students through various events organized in order to identify their career goals and provide insights into the present-day competitive job market in order to propel their professional and personal growth.
