EVENT REPORTS

In its inaugural year, the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan society started with an **orientation session led by Professor K.P. Singh**, equipping volunteers with project skills, **followed by an electoral awareness**

street play that engaged villagers and promoted voter participation. Both events laid a strong foundation for community outreach and civic engagement, setting the tone for future activities.

1. Orientation Session by Professor P.K. Singh

The Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) Society hosted an orientation session on November 27, 2024, from 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. in room L110 at Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi. The programme featured Professor P.K. Singh, Project Director of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, IIT Delhi, as the chief guest and speaker. Professor P.K. Singh provided an overview of UBA's objectives, activities, and community engagement model. The orientation explained the society's structure, roles, and planned initiatives, helping students understand how they can contribute to rural development.



Our Society coordinators and faculty were present including Society Convenor Dr. Green Awasthi, Dr. Gitika Yadav, Dr. Atithi Pant, Dr. Trishala Chauhan, and Dr. Padma Dolkar. Nearly 60 students attended the session. The session concluded with a brief Q&A and encouraged strong student participation in upcoming UBA projects and village outreach activities.

2. “Electoral Awareness” Street Play

On February 1, 2025, at 11:30 a.m., the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Society of Kamala Nehru College, in collaboration with Lakshya: The Theatre Society, staged a street play on electoral awareness at Jaat Chaupal, Humayunpur Village. The programme aimed to inform and motivate villagers about the importance of voting, voter rights, and responsible civic participation.

The students performed a Nukkad Natak that highlighted common electoral issues, followed by an interactive discussion with local residents to address questions and clarify voting procedures. Our Society Convenor Dr. Green Awasthi and faculty members supported the activity, and pamphlets with voter information were distributed to attendees. The event strengthened community engagement on democratic participation and concluded with villagers sharing feedback and commitments to participate in upcoming elections.
