QUESTION MAKING WORKSHOP (in collaboration with Deshbandhu College, University of Delhi)

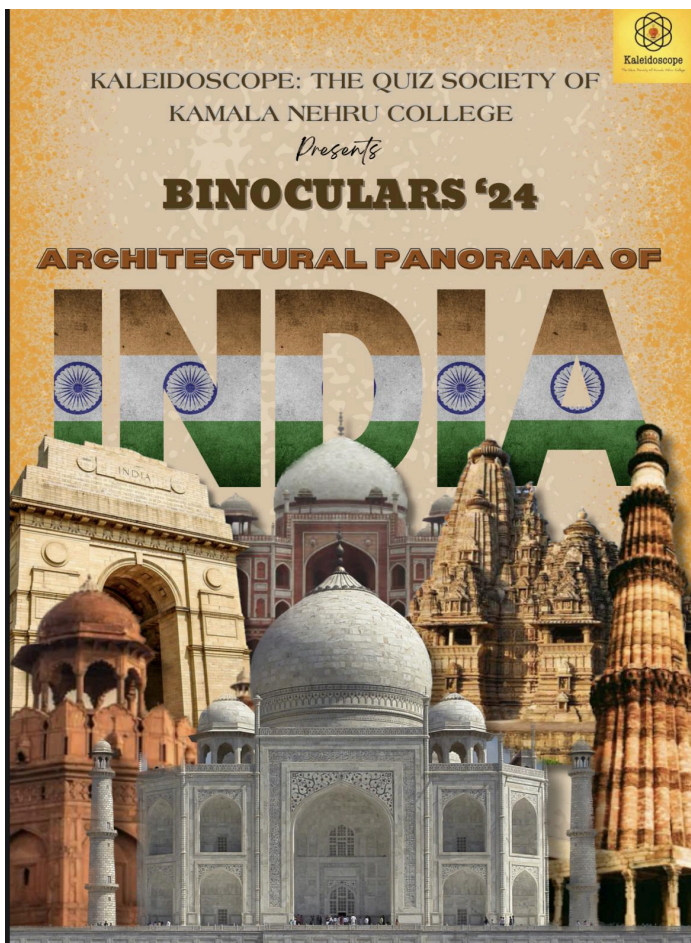

The Quiz took place on the 24th of April, 2024, from 1:00 PM to 3:30 PM in L208, with around 20 teams participating. The quizmasters for the prelim round were Ms. Shubhika Jakhar and Ms. Vishakha, while Ms. Dhriti and Ms. Khushi Bharadwaj took over as quizmasters for the finals. The event was hosted by Ms. Manika Chauhan.

Participants engaged in multiple rounds, including a written prelim round followed by an audio-visual round, general quiz, and a rapid-fire finale. The questions spanned topics related to Indian history, culture, politics, and current events.

The winners were:

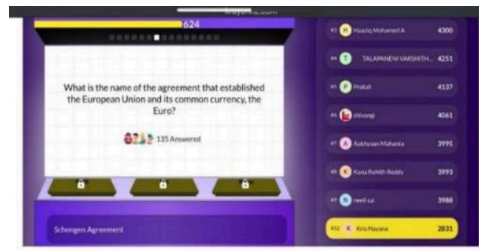

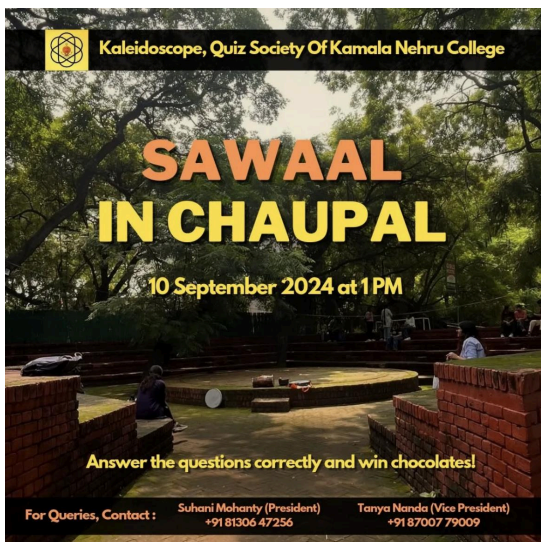


WHO RUN THE WORLD? - A World Politics Quiz (Kaleidoscope X Krayonnz)

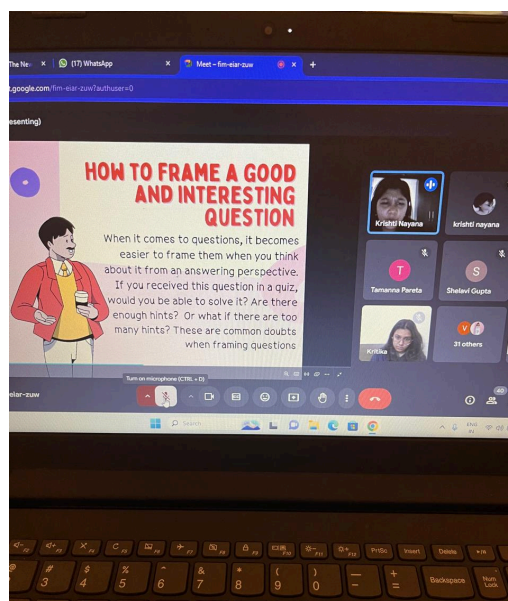
RECRUITMENT DRIVE

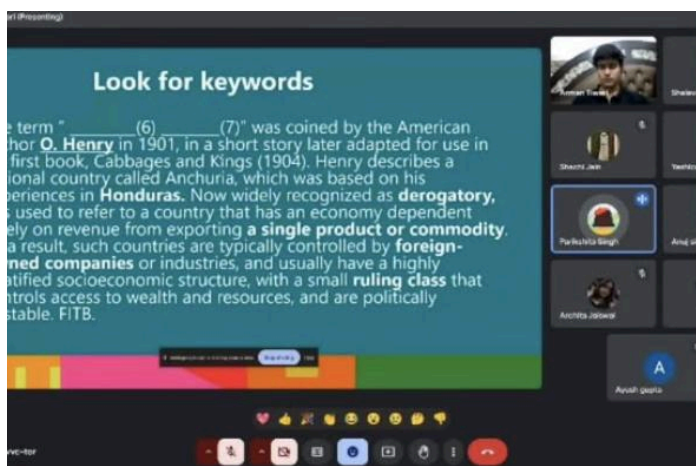
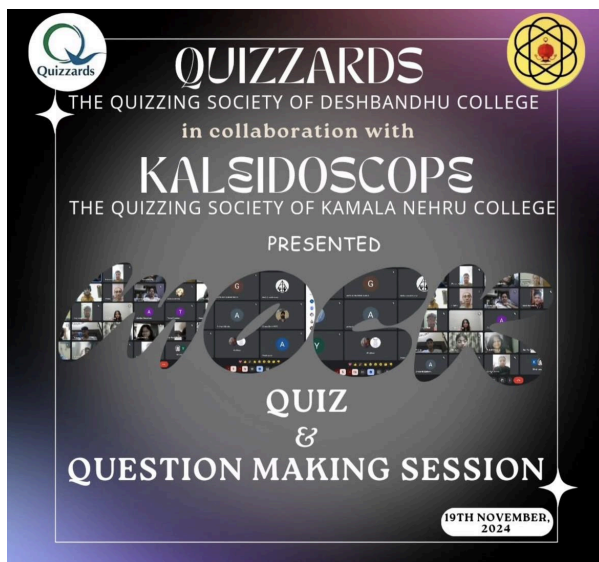

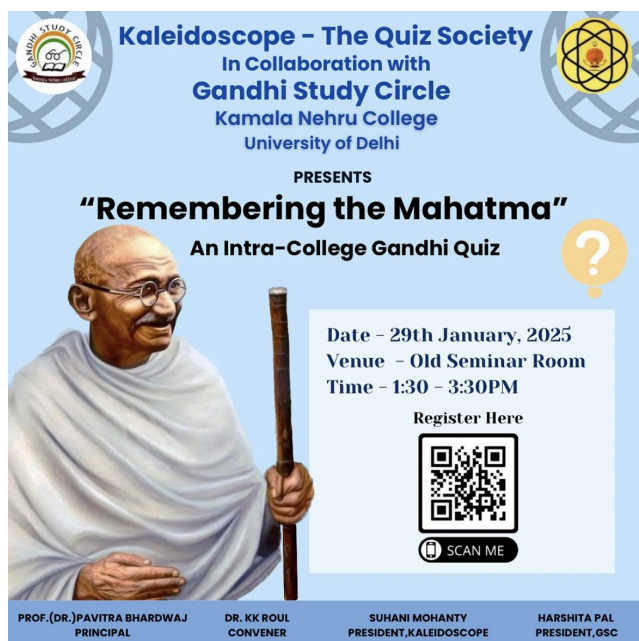
