

**REPORT ON QURUKSHETRA – AN INTER-COLLEGE QUIZ COMPETITION  
ORGANISED BY QUIZ SOCIETY KALEIDOSCOPE ON 9<sup>th</sup> APRIL, 2026 DURING  
ULLAS 2026:-**

On 9th April, Kaleidoscope- The Quiz Society of Kamala Nehru College, University of Delhi, successfully organized its annual flagship quiz event, \*Qurukshetra, under the aegis of Ullas 2026, the annual cultural fest of Kamala Nehru College. The event witnessed enthusiastic participation, seeing participation from over 35 teams made up of two members each. It was conducted in a highly engaging and well-structured manner. The event was held at NSR from 10.30am onwards.

The event comprised two quizzes. The primary segment was the LIMCA (Literature, Internet, Movies, Culture, and Art) Quiz, called ‘Pulp Fiction.’ This quiz served as the main attraction of the event and was conducted in two stages: the Preliminary Round and the Final Round. The prelims saw wide participation, from which the top 9 teams qualified for the finals, where they competed in an intense and intellectually stimulating contest. The Pulp Fiction Quiz was conducted by the Quizmaster, Krishti, President of the society, who ensured a smooth flow and engaging experience throughout.

In addition to the main quiz, a written CHAI (Countries and Capitals, History, Animation, and Innovation) Quiz titled ‘Chandni Chowk to CHAI-na’ was organized as a written round to keep the audience engaged. This segment added a dynamic and interactive element to the event, encouraging broader participation and maintaining the lively atmosphere. The CHAI Quiz was conducted by Shachi and Paarthvi, both serving as General Secretary and Joint Secretary of Kaleidoscope, respectively, who effectively engaged the audience with their well-curated questions.
